Adult Cancer Survivorship

Nearly 10 million cancer survivors in U.S.¹

•3–4% of entire U.S. population

14% of cancer survivors diagnosed \geq 20 years ago²

For adults diagnosed with cancer, 5-year survival 60%²

Adult cancer survivors at risk for late effects of treatment³

Models of Care: Examples

- Primary vs. oncology provider
- General oncology vs. separate survivorship
- General vs. disease or treatment specific
- Consultative model vs. practice model
