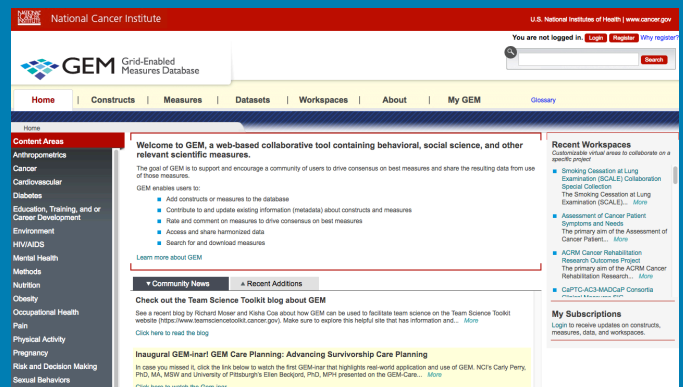
The Grid-Enabled Measures (GEM) portal is a dynamic, web-based tool that allows users to engage in collaborative research.

Researchers may use the wiki-based platform to crowd-source consensus on common measures.

Custom Workspaces enable users to collaborate on specific content areas and disseminate the results of their consensus initiatives with other researchers, practitioners, and clinicians.

- Facilitates knowledge synthesis through the use of common measures and improves comparability across studies.
- Enables researchers to establish user-defined criteria for measure evaluation through custom Workspaces.
