

# K Award eligibility requirements

- Research or health professional doctorate degree
- U.S. citizenship or permanent residency
  - Except K99/R00
- Identification of a mentor/mentoring team
  - Except K22 programs
- K award-specific eligibility limitations (years of postdoctoral research experience, funding history/ previous NIH awards, clinical degree, clinical license, clinical duties, etc.)

### K Awards provide:

- "Protected time" for research and research training for 3-5 years
  - Salary + fringe benefits
    - Minimum of 75% effort required
- Funds for research development support
  - Tuition & fees
  - Travel to scientific meetings, workshops, field sites
  - Research expenses, including technical personnel
  - Statistical services, computer time, etc.

#### Mentored K Awards

K08 Mentored Clinical Scientist Research Career Development Award(K23 Mentored Patient-Oriented Research Career Development Award)

### NCI-specific mentored K awards:

- K08 NCI Mentored Clinical Scientist Research Career Development Award to Promote Diversity
- K01 NCI Mentored Research Scientist Development Award to Promote Diversity

### Transition K Awards: K99/R00

#### **K99/R00** NIH Pathway to Independence Award

- Open to applicants with U.S. visas
- Eligibility limited to ≤ 4 years postdoctoral research experience
- Dual-phase funding:
  - K99 (mentored K) phase = 1-2 Years
    - Awardee secures a tenure-track assistant professor position (or equivalent)
  - R00 (independent) phase = \$249K/year for 3 years

#### Transition K Awards: K22

#### **K22** NCI Transition K Award

#### **K22** NCI Transition K Award to Promote Diversity

- No mentor
- Candidate must be in non-independent position; ready to be independent
- If selected for funding, the awardee has 12 months to secure a tenuretrack assistant professor position (or equivalent)
- Then awarded independent research support for 3 years
- Awardee must apply for R01 funding by the end of Year 2 of the K22
